

## **Justice Street Elementary School** **2010-2011 Grade Level School Supplies**

The following is a grade level “donation/shopping list” of basic school supplies that we are asking each child to bring to school. Please shop at either Office Depot (mention Justice St. to the clerk) or at Target using your Target card (if you are not already registered, you can do so on line). By supplying your child with the following donations and basic school materials, you can help Justice save thousands of dollars. As you can see, the classroom supply lists are rather extensive. Due to the lack of storage space and concern for duplication of materials, teachers prefer **gift cards** to Office Depot, Staples, Lakeshore, and Target, which will allow the teachers to buy classroom materials as needed during the year. This money saved can be directed towards the purchase of reading, writing, and math materials and other supporting resources. The supplies bought at the 99 Cents Store and Dollar Tree may have ingredients and qualities which are prohibited by the Division of Environmental Safety, so please do not purchase supplies from these type venues. We truly appreciate your assistance in this matter. Classroom supplies should **not** be labeled (teachers will be responsible for disseminating supplies). Periodically check with your teacher throughout the year for additional classroom supplies needed. We **greatly** appreciate any help you can provide.
