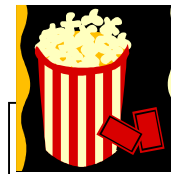

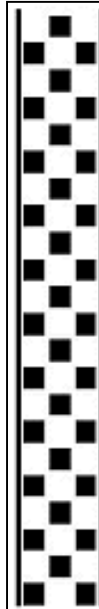

**Trick or Treat Tips**

As Halloween approaches, the nights will continue to get darker. In order to make sure that the night starts and ends well, there are a few measures that can be taken to ensure this.

- If a group of young children are going door-to-door asking the well know trick or treat question, it's vital that they stay within sight of you.
